

### **When Will I Get My Refund?**

So you filed your return and are expecting a refund. You might be wondering just how long it might take to get your refund from the IRS. If you filed with an old fashion paper return, it should take about six to eight weeks from the day the IRS receives your return.

If you filed your return electronically, then you should receive your refund in about 10 business days. Our website has links to the Federal and Arizona websites that can show you when to expect your refund with just a few clicks of the mouse. All you will need to know is your social security number, filing status and the exact amount of your refund.

Refunds can be issued through a mailed check or through direct deposit. Direct deposit is always more ideal since it is faster and more secure than waiting for the US Treasury to issue a paper check.

### **I should have received my refund by now**

There are many reasons that you may not receive your refund as quickly as you might expect. Some of these reasons include:

- You may not have attached your W-2
- You may have forgotten to sign your return
- Inputting your SSN incorrectly, so that it does not match the IRS records.
- Mathematical errors
